SOCIAL CARE VACCINATIONS

From today (11th Feb) an additional route for eligible frontline health and social care workers to book their first vaccination appointment via the National Booking System, initially for two weeks, to increase uptake among eligible staff.

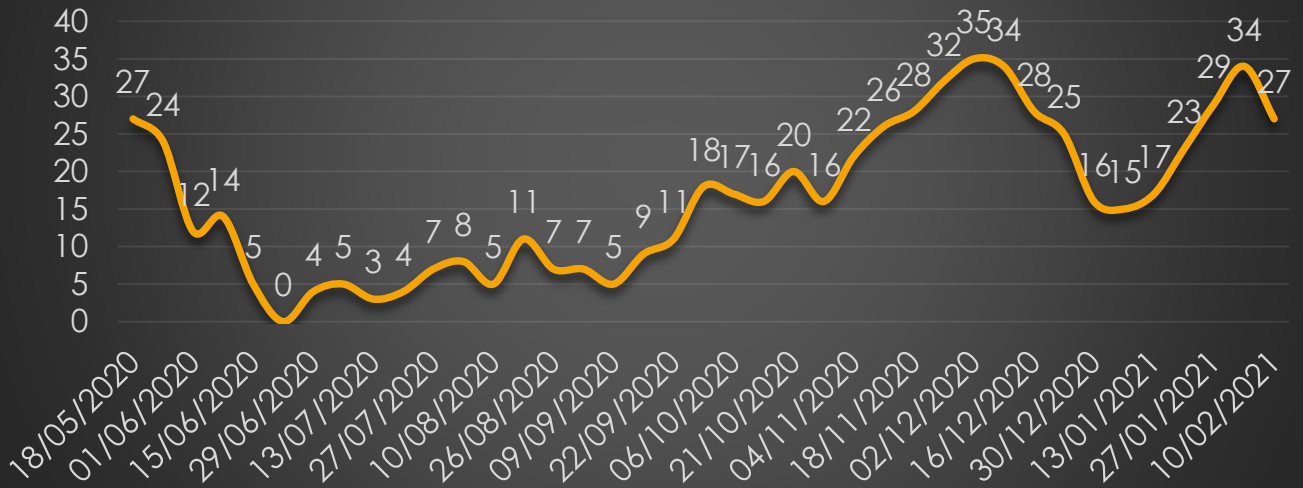

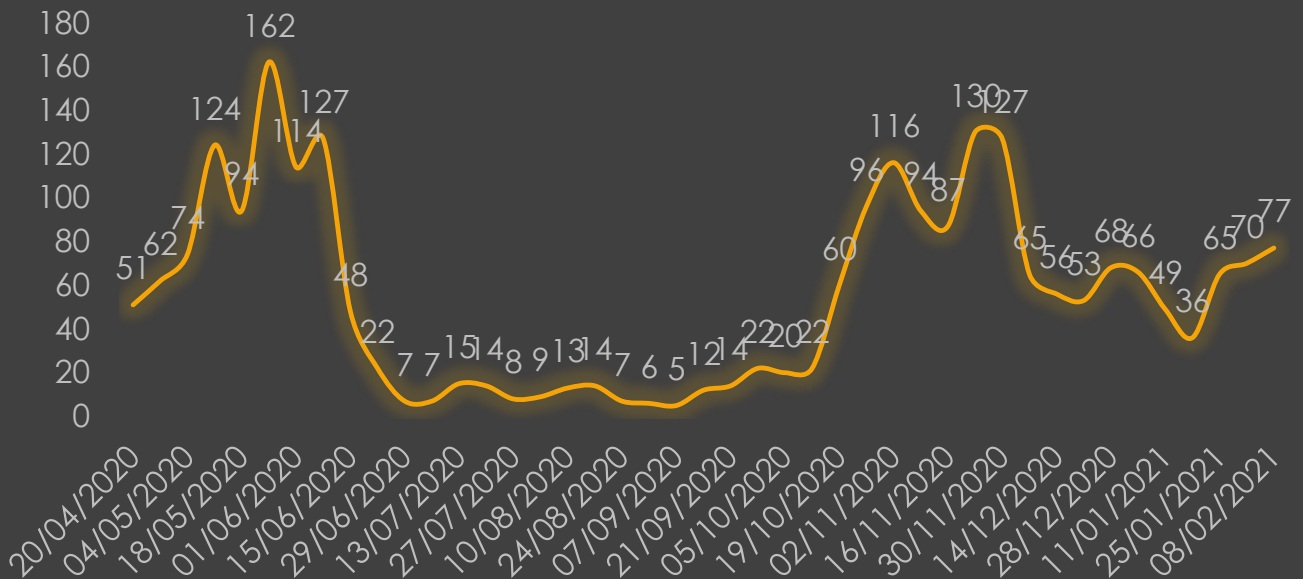
BRADFORD CARE HOMES COVID-19 TRACKER
