We will take referrals and are also offering regular **Welfare and Companion calls** throughout the Convid 19 crisis.

We are taking new referrals for our **Side by Side service** in Leeds and Wakefield and continuing our work with Dementia Friendly Communities in Bradford

The Alzheimer's Society has developed a virtual Singing for the Brain offer which is being rolled out through some of the region.
