

Windows 11 Upgrade Process

What's happening?

With Windows 10 reaching end of life in October 2025, it is highly recommended to start thinking about the next steps.

Microsoft recommends that users upgrade to Windows 11 to continue receiving updates and keep their systems secure. If you are unable to upgrade devices, it's possibly due to the age of the hardware and will need to be replaced.

Thankfully, this is a relatively painless process, and it won't be difficult for users to adjust to the upgrade.

What does this mean for you?

Devices that reach 'end of life' means that they will no longer receive security updates. This affects all businesses and users that use any device running a Windows 10 Operating System.

Security updates are vital for keeping your systems up to date and secure. This helps protect against malware and cyber-attacks from zero-day vulnerabilities and exploits.

When do we need to upgrade?

The upgrade process should happen before October 2025, and we recommend at least 6 months before as new hardware is likely to be released that may be helpful to your business.
