#### Have you suffered from COVID-19?

Do you still experience excessive tiredness or muscle weakness? Are you feeling stressed over not being able to do what you used to do?

You may suffer from what the media has termed 'Long COVID'. This term has been used to describe symptoms lasting longer than expected. These symptoms can include but are not limited to:

- Breathlessness/ shortness of breath
- Extreme tiredness or fatique
- Problems with memory and concentration or "brain fog"
- Difficulty sleeping
- Joint pain
- Depression & anxiety
- Stomach problems & loss of appetite
- Altered voice quality, communication difficulties, swallowing issues.

#### What is the PCWBS offering to help with 'Long COVID'?

Our 7-week Recovering from COVID Course could help you stay on track and optimise your recovery. The course is for ALL social health and care staff working across Bradford District, Airedale & Craven. This includes all trust staff, council and care home staff.

#### How is the course delivered and who is it delivered by?

The course is delivered virtually in the comfort of your own home or office over

Microsoft Teams (free to download) lead by a Multidisciplinary team consisting of a Psychologist, Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist, Dietitian and Personal Support Navigator.

#### How can I enroll on the course and when is the start date?

#### FOR THE ATTENTION OF MANAGERS AND STAFF IN CARE HOMES, EXTRA CARE AND SUPPORTED LIVING SETTINGS

You may be aware that the North East, like many other regions in England, is experiencing an increase in cases of Covid-19.

This may be causing concern for yourself and colleagues, residents, service users and family members, especially given the vulnerability of people in your setting.

Whilst cases in care settings remain at a low level we are starting to see a small increase across the region and anticipate that this will continue, especially given the impact of new variants of Covid-19.

The system of controls that you all have in place to prevent Covid-19, alongside the vaccination of those who need to have one or both injections, is essential to help prevent cases of Covid-19 and ensure that where cases do occur wider transmission can be prevented.

All staff have been working so hard to keep everyone safe for a long time and no doubt everyone is exhausted but continuing all the hard work yourself and colleagues have been doing is the best way to keep everyone safe.

Infection Prevention and Control – everyone must continue to follow the required measures for safe living, working and visiting in care settings. This includes the correct use of PPE, cleaning and hand hygiene.

Vaccination – if staff and residents have not received their 1st or 2nd vaccine continue to encourage them to do so, as this helps to protect them and others.

Testing – the testing requirements in place for staff, residents, visitors and visiting professionals must still be followed.

Visiting (in and out) – ensure awareness and compliance with current visiting guidance

advise on any requirements for outbreak testing.


