

Triple A Screening Clinic

Triple A screening is a one-off ultrasound scan offered to all men aged 65 +. This can identify if someone is at risk of having an abdominal aortic aneurism, which can be fatal. If this is picked up, it can be easily treated.

We are running a Triple A screening clinic for men with learning disabilities at Waddiloves as some men with learning disabilities have not attended Triple A screening when offered.

This is a one-off scan so if you have had it before you do not need to attend again.

We are running a Triple A screening clinic at Waddiloves on the 25th March 2021, with the screening radiographers - if you would like to book on please contact Victoria.donnelly@bdct.nhs.uk
