### **Application Process**

  - 2. Initial Assessment: Our team will review the application and conduct an assessment to determine suitability.
- 3. Support Planning: If accepted, we will co-produce a support plan with the individual to address their needs and goals, prioritising urgent tenancy sustainment issues where required.
