# **AMBER HEAT HEALTH ALERT ISSUED**

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) has issued amber and yellow heat health alerts as a heatwave is expected to impact large parts of England. The amber alert, indicating a *significant impact on health and social care services*, is in place from midday Today through to 8pm Tuesday.

In addition, rising humidity levels may increase discomfort and risk, particularly for vulnerable groups.

Periods of extreme heat present serious risks to people receiving care, especially:

- Older adults
- Individuals with long term conditions
  - People with reduced mobility
- Those taking certain medications affecting hydration or temperature regulation
- Both care homes and community-based services should take proactive steps to safeguard health and wellbeing.
