PLEASE UPDATE THE CAPACITY TRACKER

The Adult Social Care Information (Enforcement) Regulations 2022 remain in force. The legislation requires all ASC providers regulated by the CQC to update the mandated collection in the Capacity Tracker.

Providers who did not submit an ASC update in the previous 2 windows (April & May 2025) are at risk of receiving a Notice of Intent and a fixed penalty (normally to the value of their CQC registration fee) if they do not update in June 2025.

Providers are urged to ensure they submit an ASC update on the Capacity Tracker as soon as possible.

The current compliance window opened on Sunday 8th June and will close on Monday 16th June 2025.
