

## DAY SERVICES REOPENING

As you will be aware, stage four of the governments roadmap out of restrictions has been delayed until **19 July 2021**, four weeks after the initial proposal. As a result day service will not be able to fully reopen until this date. We still require your risk assessment to be **submitted to the Covid-19 Support Team via the email [Covid19SupportTeam@bradford.gov.uk](mailto:Covid19SupportTeam@bradford.gov.uk)** at your earliest convenience in line with government guidance surrounding stage four of the roadmap. Any risk assessments that have been submitted already have been categorised and we will begin to contact anyone that requires a follow up shortly.

For those yet to submit their risk assessment, the Covid-19 Support Team will be contacting you directly over the next two weeks. The aim will be to obtain and, where required, support with your risk assessment in preparation of reopening your service partially or fully. Should you have any issues in the meantime, please contact the team at the email address above or via our duty number 01274 431999. We are committed to working with you to support your service to re-commence.

## CQC and the DSPT

The DSPT is a very effective way of providing evidence to inspectors. You may be aware of CQC's interim guidance on digital records which states that "all records must comply with...the Data Security and Protection Toolkit (where providers have access to NHS patient data and systems)".

This echos the current DSPT information standard which says "All organisations that have access to NHS patient data and systems must use this Toolkit to provide assurance that they are practising good data security and that personal information is handled correctly." This means that should a care provider achieve standards met, they will be able to take part in local shared records projects, proxy access to medication etc where these projects are available.

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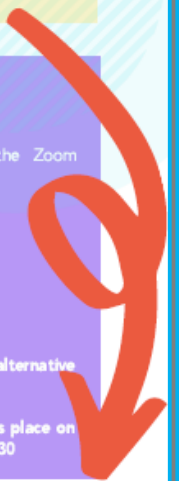
