REMINDER TO UPDATE SUS / CAPACITY TRACKER

WALK-IN PCR APPOINTMENTS AT MASS TESTING SITES IN BRADFORD

As social care staff you are able to access walk-in PCR testing appointments at the following sites:

Centenary Square, Bradford Victoria Hall, Keighley

You can access these sites from 8am to 6pm, but if you're going later in the day or nearer closing time, please ensure at least 30 minutes to allow for processing and registering your test before you leave.

Please ensure to take your staff ID, as even at busy times, this will mean you are given priority and an appointment will be made available to you. It does not mean you will be fast tracked, but they will ensure you are able to access a test whilst you are there.
