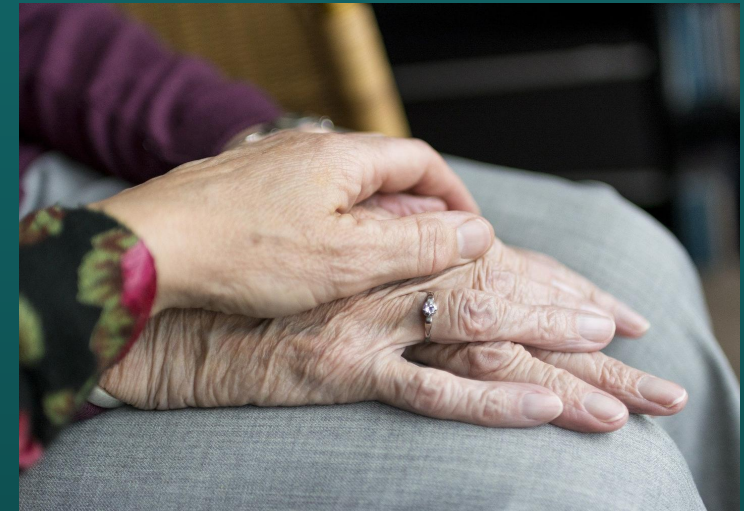

All courses are fully funded at no cost to the learner, providing they meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Live in England - Has lived in the EU for 3 years, for purposes other than study - Not currently enrolled on an apprenticeship - 19+ at the start of the academic year - 19-23 year olds must already hold a full level 2 qualification, this is equivalent to 5 A to C GCSEs - Must not have completed any part of the qualification previously
