


Update

- Increasing R rate As lock down measures continue to be relaxed, I'm sure that like me, you will have concerns about potential increase in infection in the community and the risk to vulnerable people and care staff. It does appear that the R number is starting to increase in our region and Bradford has been identified as a place with higher rates than other areas. As I'm sure you will be doing, please keep supporting your staff to understand what they need to do both inside and outside of work to minimise their risks. Please also look at what you can do to incentivise staff not to be at work when they may be unwell by using the IPC grant to pay them beyond the SSP if they can't be in work.
- **Testing** For older people's care homes registering with the national portal for the whole home retesting programme please let us know of any issues you are experiencing. Marley Field will continue to be available until your new arrangements are in place. For other providers we are in the process of rolling out a repeat staff testing offer through Marley Field and will be sending further details through the bulletin as soon as we can.
- Care Home Resilience Plan Review we are working to review the plan of how we support care homes and all other independent sector adult social care provision over the coming months
- Home Care Forum will be held on the BCA Zoom platform on Thursday 16th July
- There remains low numbers of outbreaks in care homes and the majority of these are asymptomatic and discovered through whole home testing arrangements - see next slide
