## Practice Assessor Preparation -Skills for Care



This webinar and associated learning resources will prepare social care professionals to supervise and assess learners working in social care areas and students studying on a range of social care programmes including those leading to registration with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC).

#### Training package
