CYBER SECURITY SURVEY

The National Care Forum (NCF) and Voluntary Organisations Disability Group (VODG) have been commissioned by the Better Security Better Care programme and Digital Care Hub to research the ways in which social care charities and not-for-profit organisations are particularly susceptible to cyberattacks, and whether there are certain patterns/approaches that are used to target these organisations. The aim is to make recommendations for strengthening or targeting support for the sector. This project focuses particularly on social care which is frequently only considered alongside health.

Key to this work is hearing from providers that are charities/not-for-profit organisations. Their insights are vital to our work and will help shape key recommendations that will advance digital best practice in the sector.
