

Identification and management of outbreaks of **COVID-19** in care/residential homes

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Yorkshire & the Humber



Have two or more residents (or staff) in the same area of the care home had <u>any</u> of the following symptoms within 14 days of each other?







A new, continuous cough

New onset of influenza like illness or worsening shortness of breath











What the HPT will do:

- Work with care home staff to identify the cause of the outbreak
- Advise on infection prevention and control measures

Ensure standard infection control measures are put in place immediately, including (but not limited to):

- Isolate resident for 14 days from symptom onset.
- Suspend visitor access to affected resident(s) for 14 days from symptom onset.
- Staff in contact with the resident to use appropriate PPE.
- Care home to ensure all staff, visitors and residents are aware of and practice good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- Ensure appropriate cleaning procedures are adhered to.
- We advise if any staff members are symptomatic (temperature ≥37.8'C or new, continuous cough) then they should selfisolate at home for 7 days from symptom onset.
- Check the government website gov.uk/coronavirus for the latest guidance on admission and care of residents during Covid-19 incident in a care home, cleaning in non-healthcare settings, and staying at home guidance (for staff and visitors).
- If patient requires hospital transfer, please ensure receiving department and ambulance service are informed of outbreak.
