R&N TENDER UPDATE

As previously communicated, The Council wishes to replace its current Framework with the Bradford and District Residential and Nursing Care Homes Provider List of accredited Providers. The new approach is intended to be a more flexible, straight-forward approach for organisations that wish to apply in order to receive business from the Council.

The process has been subject to delays as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic, however we can now announce to potential bidders that the Council intends to publish the tender opportunity on **I June 2021**. The first round will remain open for submissions for a 6 week period, and will remain open thereafter in a series of subsequent rounds.

In advance of this date, and in consideration of the time elapsed since the Market Engagement Event held in February 2020, we are now conducting final market engagement by circulating a working draft of the service specification, for bidder consideration and feedback, prior to finalisation and inclusion in the tender pack.

This is available through YORtender. If you would like to feedback or comment on this draft, please reply using the YORtender message function. We will accept comments until 5pm on Monday 10 May.

QUARANTINE GUIDANCE FROM DHSC

For the purposes of quarantine, DHSC considers a newly arrived care worker not to be equivalent to a member of the client's household (in the sense that on arrival, the worker cannot be regarded in the same way as a family member or friend would be).

DHSC has therefore advised against care workers who are required to quarantine doing so in the home of a client, for reasons described in more detail, below. In addition, DHSC states that delivering social care or support during the quarantine period would not meet the requirements of quarantine (which asks those quarantining in a private residence to avoid contact with other people in the household "as far as possible").

This advice is different from that given by DHSC in July 2020, before new variants were identified and transmission rates in other countries increased. Although the advice from DHSC may change again at some point in the future, subject to the variants of coronavirus in circulation and the vaccination of workers from outside the UK increasing.
