TENDER PROCESS FOR THE BRADFORD & DISTRICT RESIDENTIAL & NURSING CARE HOMES PROVIDER LIST

The tender process for the Bradford & District Residential & Nursing Care Homes Provider List is now open. The current round will close on 12 October 2021 which is the last opportunity should you wish to be considered for the Provider List in time for the start date of 1 November 2021. It is important that you apply to be on the List as from this date ALL providers of Residential and Nursing care in the Bradford District need to be accredited in order to receive new Council and/ or CCG funded business. You may still apply after this date (12th October) but will not be able to receive new business from 1 November until the next round closes again.

If you have previously expressed an interest in this opportunity on YORtender, you should have received an email from ProContract with a link to the live opportunity. Alternatively you can search on YORtender using the full title, or by reference number DN420609. We have made every effort to make the application process as straightforward as possible so please consider submitting before this day. CAPACITY TRACKER UPDATE REGARDING COVID EXEMPTION SELF-CERTIFICATION AND THOSE VACCINATED ABROAD

Capacity Tracker will begin to capture this information from Monday I I October. Capacity Tracker guidance on how to complete the new vaccination information will be published shortly within the Resource Centre, What's New Section and a new notification posted on the Capacity Tracker message board when it becomes available.

COVID-19 VACCINATION UPWANTETER Share

- Staff members who are double vaccinated can receive a booster jab 6 months after their second dose of their COVID-19 vaccine.
- Those who have a temporary exemption have until 28
 October to receive their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, in order to be doubly vaccinated by 23 December.

 Temporary self-exemptions will expire on 23 December.
- Pregnant women are also eligible for a time-limited exemption. Should pregnant women take this route, their exemption will expire 16-weeks post-partum to allow them to be vaccinated.
- Unvaccinated staff and those without an exemption will not be able to work in a care home from 11 November.
- Staff who have not received their second dose by 11
 November will not be able to work in a care home from 11.
 November. They will be able to return to work once they
 are doubly vaccinated.
