

## School based childcare provision

Schools are providing childcare for children with identified vulnerabilities, key worker children and those with Educational Health and Care Plans, where it is appropriate to do so. Schools are providing distance learning to all children on their roll. School safeguarding responsibilities remain.

Schools are, on the most part, providing childcare between 8am and 6pm.

They are also providing to meals to children who are hungry. At present some schools are doing this by doorstep home delivery and others are scheduling pick up times during the day.

The schools that are open are inevitably changing on a daily basis, dependant on need and staffing numbers. The Local Authority is working with schools, where they need to close, to identify alternative schools within the local community to allow childcare provision to continue.
