EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME – **LAST CALL** - FINAL WEBINAR - NO RECOURSE TO PUBLIC FUNDS (NRPF)

ADASS will be hosting a final EUSS Webinar on the 15th September. This is the last opportunity to hear from the No Recourse to Public Funds (NRPF) Forum about this important issue. A “must attend” event for organisations within Adult Social Care and specifically to Local Authorities who need to be aware of how this might impact on their services and finances. Vulnerable adults who have still not applied could be facing homelessness and destitution. Please see the [LINK](#) to the latest factsheet for information.

Please cascade this information within your organisations in preparation for the potential impact on front line services should EU/EEA citizens without lawful residence seek emergency assistance with housing and personal support.

Home Office Grant Funded Organisations will cease to receive further funding from the end of September - time is now running out for seeking support from over 70 national organisations who are currently providing invaluable advice and support to help people make applications to the scheme. 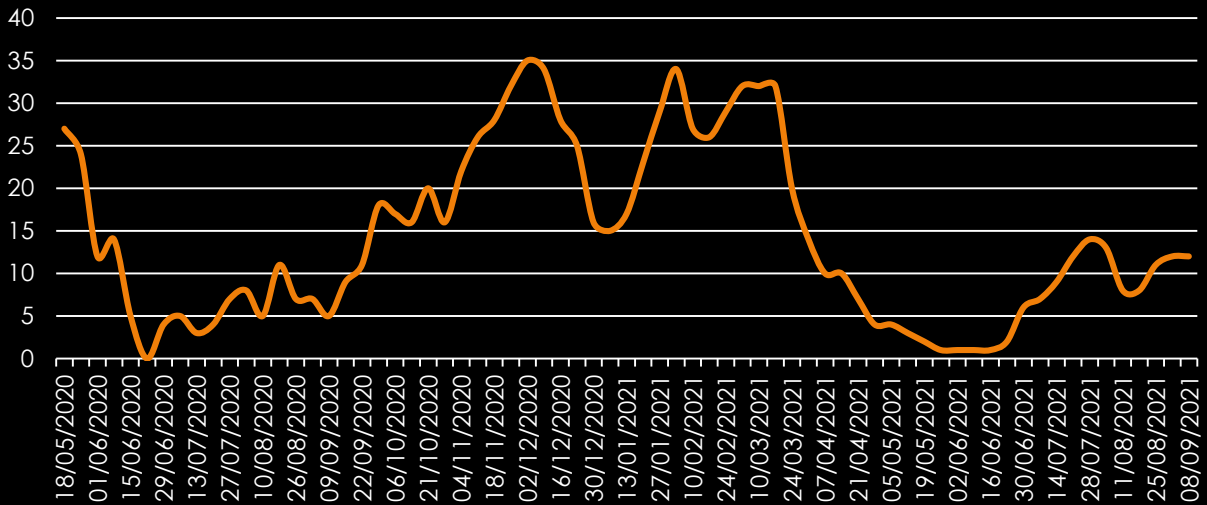

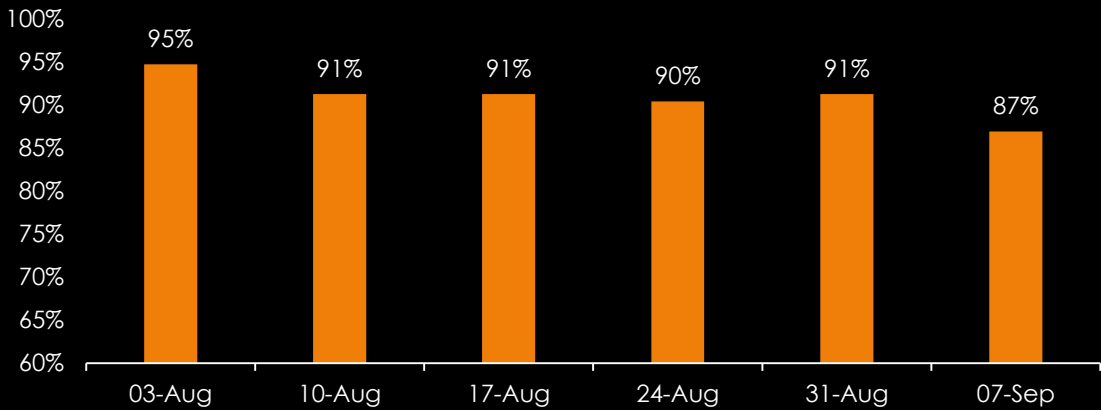
