ONLINE BRITISH SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETING SERVICE

West Yorkshire Metro is trialling a new online BSL on demand interpreting service, to enable customers to communicate with their transport service teams via BSL online or in person.

The service, delivered in partnership with <u>SignLive</u>, connects BSL users with professional interpreters via a video link, ensuring seamless communication between interpreters and BSL users. Interpreters will relay messages to colleagues and will sign responses back.

Customers can access the following customer support teams with the help of a fully accredited interpreter via real-time video relay services:

To use this new service customers will need to:

- Create an account through the SignLive website or app
- Search for 'West Yorkshire Combined Authority' in the directory to find the relevant Metroline team.
- Tell a BSL interpreter what you want to find out when you have been automatically connected.

The interpreter will relay the conversation to one of our team members in real-time.

This new service can also be used by customers in person at our Bus Stations and Travel Centres listed below. Customers will be able to use their own devices to connect to an online BSL Interpreter.


