### **UK SPF COMMUNITY GRANTS**

Groundwork is working with the West Yorkshire Combined Authority to deliver Community Grants, a programme designed to support people with complex barriers to move towards employment and digital inclusion. Projects should support people who struggle to engage with mainstream provision, including those who are 'socially excluded' e.g. those with long term health problems. The programme will offer grants between £15,000 and £50,000 to voluntary, community and social enterprise groups across West Yorkshire. The scheme opens in May 2024 for applications with rolling grant panels. Successful projects will be expected to complete delivery by December 2024. #### A new service to provide discharge to assess from hospital into independent Residential and Nursing homes

City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council are commissioning a new service on behalf of the ICB to provide discharge to assess from hospital into the independent sector. The new service will provide people with a 4-week assessment period in a care home (nursing or residential) to support in determining their longer-term care requirements.

An opportunity to work in partnership to deliver safe and timely discharges from hospital into a care home, ensuring people have their needs assessed to enable them to receive the most appropriate long-term care placement and support.
