WRAPAROUND CHILDCARE FOR PRIMARY AGED CHILDREN

If you need extra help before or after the school day, wraparound childcare is here to help parents and carers of primary school aged children.

Families can access wraparound childcare linked to a primary school on either the school site, or another local setting such as a community centre, a nursery, or by a childminder from 8am – 6pm (weekdays), during term time.

Speak to your child's school who will be able to share information with you about wraparound childcare options in your local area. You can then contact your chosen provider directly to check their availability.

Once you have chosen a provider, you can enquire and pay them directly for your child's place. You might qualify for [help with the costs](#) too.
