JU:MP

The JU:MP programme is delivering world-leading results in Bradford.

New research from Born in Bradford and the University of Bradford, found that Active Bradford's programme improved children's total physical activity by over 70 minutes per week - bigger than any other long-term population level physical activity intervention for children reported in comparable scientific research studies so far.

JU:MP has reached over 30,000 children and families over five years through community-led interventions including 'Healthy Madrasas', Creating Active Schools in 57 Bradford schools, co-designed green spaces for adolescent girls, and transformed local parks.

This has prompted Sport England to renew its commitment to Bradford with a new £4 million investment and three-year partnership. The success is credited to a place-based way of working that brings together local organisations and leaders who understand their communities' specific needs, with Sport England having invested around £12 million in this approach in Bradford since 2018.
