GUIDANCE ON SUPPORTING TEST AND TRACE – UKHCA UPDATE

As the Government's Test and Trace system increases in scope, we wish to draw your attention to Section 3 of the recent guidance published for home support services, which includes information under the heading "How home care providers can support the NHS Test and Trace service".

Key points include:

- You may be asked to provide information at short notice if contacted by Test and Trace.
- You may wish to update your data protection privacy policy to specify that information you already hold might be shared with NHS Test and Trace.

We are confident that providers will want to act responsibly when asked for information that may help to reduce the transmission of coronavirus, and that they will want to ensure that they can act quickly when asked to do so.

Government had originally proposed considerably more burdensome requirements on providers and UKHCA is pleased that feedback we gave to the Department for Health and Social Care has informed the guidance which has been published.
