PPE UPDATE FOR ALL PROVIDERS

This is a reminder to providers that you may need to order more PPE:

- Everybody will probably need more visors
- Home care providers need to ensure that they have a mask for every visit
- Care home providers may need some more masks, as PPE may be changed more frequently

Free PPE is still available through the PPE Portal however it is important to be aware that this is currently set to finish at the end of June, although the scheme will be reviewed again in April to determine the provision of PPE beyond the end of June.

VACCINATIONS FOR **AGENCY STAFF**

Please be aware that agency staff are eligible for the Covid-19 vaccine and therefore entitled to book in using the National Booking System as part of priority group 2

PROVIDERS, WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Bradford's statistics for vaccine take up in our care services is being reported lower than the regional average. We believe that this is not necessarily the case and know how hard you have all worked to make sure people are as safe and protected as possible.

The Capacity Tracker is the only statistical report that is used when calculating the uptake for Covid-19 vaccinations for social care staff.

We really need your help to ensure your profile and the vaccination status of your staff are up to date and reflect the real current position of your service.

We are confident that our vaccine uptake is higher than 70% of staff in care homes and 60% for community providers. That said, without your support in regularly completing the Capacity Tacker with this information Bradford will remain a below average area with regard to vaccinations.

Please take some time to review your data ASAP and let's make sure Bradford is given the recognition it deserves.

Don't forget the individual award for your service will be issued shortly, we want to encourage you to 'go for gold' or even platinum!

GUIDANCE ON VITAMIN D SUPPLEMENTS FOR CARE HOMES




