UPCOMING NATIONAL TEST ON 7 SEPTEMBER 2025

The government will be carrying out a national test of the UK Emergency Alerts system on **7 September 2025 at 3pm**.

The <u>test alert</u> will be sent to all compatible 4G and 5G mobile phones and compatible tablets across the UK.

This follows the first successful national test in April 2023.

Information about the upcoming national test is available in <u>British Sign Language</u> (BSL) and Easy Read formats.

Bradford Council's Care Home Brokerage service is launching on 3rd November 2023.

From 3rd November all new care home placements for older people will be made through the Care Home Brokerage Team. You should have received this week an email explaining what actions you need to take now to prepare for this change. EQUALITIES DATA – ANNUAL QUESTIONNAIRE OCTOBER 2025

We're pleased to let you know that, following the success of last year's initiative, the Adults Commissioning and Contracts Teams will once again be collecting equalities data from our Providers as part of our annual process.

The response in 2024 was excellent, and the information gathered has proven to be extremely valuable in helping us better understand and support the diverse communities we serve.

WEST YORKSHIRE FINANCIAL EXPLOITATION AND ABUSE TRAINING FOR PROFESSIONALS

The West Yorkshire Financial Exploitation and Abuse Team (WYFEAT) offer a free training session to professionals regarding financial abuse and exploitation, which has recently been extended to 75minute session. The session explores in depth at how financial abuse comes under The Care Act 2014, and how as professionals we can help to safeguard service users from doorstep crime and financial abuse.

We aim to address the stigma attached to being scammed and how we can change this. The training session has real case studies from victims in West Yorkshire that have been financially abused. This is to illustrate the kind of work WYFEAT undertake. The role of WYFEAT and the referral process will also be explained in detail and the session explores what practical measures are available to victims in West Yorkshire in order help combat financial abuse and prevent further victims.




