VARIATIONS TO TOP UP FEES

Just a reminder that all fees relating to accommodation in a care home, must be captured within the Care Homes Provider List contract documents. Changes in personal choice contributions (top ups) need to be documented and agreed by all parties.

When the Provider List was established, all existing placements were migrated across to the new contract. As a result of this, the above applies to all funded placements in a home, not just those who have moved in after the List was established.

DEMENTIA SYMPTOM CHECKLIST

A diagnosis of dementia can leave a person with lots of questions about what is next. However, getting an early diagnosis can help access the right support like treatments to help with symptoms. The Alzheimer's Society's dementia symptom checklist includes 20 questions about possible symptoms or behaviours relating to dementia, including;

- Memory and mental ability problems.
- Problems with daily living activities.
- Mood and behaviour problems.
- Notes on other symptoms or concerns.
- Hearing problems.
- Sight problems.

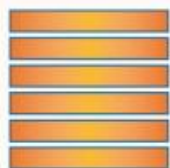
