## **PROMOTE THE VOTE**

As you will all be aware, a general election has been called for 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024. As in previous years, social workers from the Adults with Disabilities team will be working with providers to ensure that adults with learning disabilities are aware of their right to register to vote and are supported to vote if they choose to do so.

The deadline for voter registration is 18<sup>th</sup> June and ahead of this date social workers will be contacting providers to arrange suitable times to visit and will bring with them a number of accessible resources designed to support people.

Voting is central to rights-based practice and is key to enabling people to exercise their rights. Please have discussions with your staff about this really important campaign and let them know that social workers will be getting in touch. We look forward to working with you all!

#### TISSUE VIABILITY

The BDCFT Tissue Viability team deliver free pressure ulcer prevention training to care homes and agencies in the Bradford, Airedale & Wharfedale district.

From the start of January 2024, 43 training sessions have been booked and 12 of these have been cancelled on the morning of the training. These cancellations have cost the trust £715.88.

#### **EQUALITY DATA COLLECTION PILOT**

Thank you to those providers that have so far volunteered for our Equality Data Collection Pilot! We are continuing to seek more volunteers for the July pilot ahead of the full mandatory rollout for all Adult's providers in October 2024.

The pilot will involve surveying residents and service users to gather equality data, mainly regarding the protected characteristics from the Equality Act 2010. We will then seek your feedback to improve the process ahead of the full launch. The data will be collected using an online survey with service users/residents able to complete independently or with the support of staff.

We will use the information in a variety of ways as part of our contract management and commissioning work. Collecting equality data helps us to understand who is using our commissioned services, and who might be missing out because of characteristics they share. By understanding who is and isn't using services we can learn from services that are working well or work to fix problems if we find them. We will aim to reduce barriers, promote inclusivity, and it will aid service delivery & design.

This initiative is part of NHS Blood and Transplant's commitment to fostering support for blood, organ, and living kidney donation among Black, Asian, mixed heritage, and minority ethnic communities. The aim of the programme is to address the shortage of organs for individuals awaiting transplants from all Black and Asian communities by raising awareness of both deceased and living donation options.

This year, NHS Blood and Transplant is seeking applications to engage diverse communities at the grassroots level with a total of £600,000 available across blood, deceased organ and living kidney donation projects per-year for community-based projects across England and Wales. As part of NHS Blood and Transplant's commitment to investing in impactful projects, we are excited to announce that the programme will now offer the opportunity for 2-year grants, a shift from the usual 1year funding cycle.
