#### Please join us for an Extraordinary Care Home Forum next Tuesday 5 July\*

Bradford Council, along with other local authorities across the country have responsibility for understanding the costs providers incur in delivering care in our local care homes and that this should be considered within the fee setting approach and process.

In most cases, a local authority will set specific fee rates and will decide how to do this and what these rates are. By the end of September this year Bradford Council will need to have undertaken a cost of care exercise for older peoples residential and nursing homes and completed a Market Sustainability Plan.

In order to ensure we correctly capture costs, we need your help. The support we require will be in the form of information and data submission, essentially what you will have already to run your service. We anticipate the data collection submission will take a few hours. We understand and appreciate how busy you are. For that reason, we will offer a contribution of £250 towards the costs of completing the submission, payable of full completion.

\*The meeting will start at 11am and follows the usual BCA meeting from 10.30am on the same Zoom platform.We have extended the usual BCA meeting to allow for the FCOC launch at 11-12pm, using the same joining details which you can find below.

#### **CAPACITY TRACKER UPDATE**

Following the DHSC communication issued on Monday re mandatory data collection, we would like to clarify the update frequency requirement relating to vacancy information that falls within the section of the letter 'Please note however that the requests for daily data from providers by local Health & Social Care Discharge teams is separate to these requirements'

Capacity Tracker has a fundamental role as an operational tool for care homes to show their vacancies. For this to be effectively used by those concerned with sourcing placements, optimising patient flow and elective restoration across local systems (i.e., Brokerage, discharge, CHC and social care ops teams), regular updating is required – as a minimum Monday – Friday and ideally at weekends too.

Importantly, this approach will help reduce the number of speculative calls received by providers, and help providers maintain high levels of occupancy whilst providing routine information across the NHS, Ministers and Health & Social Care teams working to support the sector.



#### NEW TRAINING REQUIREMENT FOR ALL STAFF WHO SUPPORT PEOPLE WITH A LEARNING DISABILITY AND AUTISTIC PEOPLE COMING IN ON 1 JULY

From I July 2022, all health and social care providers registered with CQC must ensure that their staff receive training on learning disabilities and autism appropriate to their role. This new legal requirement is introduced by the Health and Care Act 2022.

The government will consult on and publish a code of practice in due course. In the meantime, CQC say they will provide guidance and will be looking to see whether providers have provided the required training and assessed staff. They will also be checking staff work with people appropriately and, if not, what training has been provided.
