# NATIONAL EMERGENCY ALERT TEST (23 APRIL)

**On Sunday 23 April there will be a national UK Emergency Alert test at 3pm.** This new Emergency Alert system is being rolled out by the government and will notify all phones with an alert sound - including when they are on silent.

An emergency alerts system is being launched by the UK Government to warn people, through their mobile phone, about serious nearby imminent risk to life, such as wildfires or severe flooding. An Emergency Alert looks and sounds very different to other types of notifications or messages such as SMS 'text messages'. In an emergency, your mobile phone or tablet will, depending on its settings:

- make a unique loud siren-like sound, even if it's set to silent
- vibrate
- read out the alert
- the sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds

If you receive an alert, it may also include a phone number or a link to the GOV.UK website for more information.

We are aware that such an alert, including the sound, could cause anxiety for a number of vulnerable people including those with a learning disability or those with autism. Please could you help by sharing this message to people with learning disability or those with autism as well as their families and carers.

Those experiencing domestic abuse, who for their safety have a secret or secondary mobile phone, are being advised to turn off Emergency Alerts. <u>Refuge</u> has produced <u>a video about how to do this</u>.

Please could you help by sharing information about the Emergency Alerts System and the **test on Sunday 23 April at 3pm** to your staff. Information can be found on the <u>gov.uk website</u> and the council's website has <u>links to posters</u>, <u>leaflets</u>, <u>Easy Read and social media assets</u> that you can use to help share the information.

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### YORKSHIRE AND HUMBER INTERNATIONAL RECRUITMENT RESEARCH / SCOPING PROJECT.

In case you are not aware, the UK Government has this year (2023/24) made £15 million available to help support international recruitment within the Adult Social Care sector.

The aim of the funding is to support care providers make more effective use of international recruitment, helping to grow the Adult Social Care workforce and alleviate some of the pressures that the sector is currently experiencing in relation to the recruitment and retention of staff. It is recognised that many small and medium care providers experience a number of different barriers in relation to international recruitment and that presently the process can be difficult to navigate. Yorkshire & Humber (YH) ADASS working in partnership with the Yorkshire & Humber Care Association Alliance (YH CAA) have been successful in securing some government funding to support the ethical International Recruitment (IR) of senior carer workers / care workers as well as Registered Nurses.

Initially the YH CAA has assigned the funding for the undertaking of a comprehensive scoping exercise with care providers who are currently undertaking IR, or considering IR, to learn:

what the challenges, barriers and concerns are, what has worked or is working well, what support is needed

Please consider this email as your formal invitation to take part in this scoping exercise as a care provider in the Yorkshire & Humber region. We value your views and opinions on this matter and kindly ask that you complete the attached survey by **Tuesday 2 May 2023**.




