IS GDPR COMPLIANT**

What is the DSPT?

The **Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT)** is a useful guide and a **free self-assessment tool** that can support organisations to keep people's confidential information safe. It can also help to **demonstrate that you're meets CQC expectations of good data security practice**. The DSPT helps to evidence how you are **protecting your organisation from and risk to cyber-attacks or breaches**.

Once completed it will allow you to **demonstrate to commissioners, GP's, CQC and other NHS services that you are handling information securely**. There are some key fundamentals elements that the BCA will promote such as, GDPR compliance, ICO, NHS mail, best practice, preparatory work required and also the DSPT itself.

The purpose of sharing provider contact information is to enable the BCA to provide information and updates more readily related to training; meetings and forums; enable good practice sharing; and enhance its response to you.

FIRE SAFETY GUIDANCE IN ACTION

In March 2016, a Care Home resident died after smoking a cigarette unsupervised in the designated smoking area. The resident used emollient cream, which can be flammable if allowed to build up on the skin, clothing, bedding etc. Whilst a smoking risk assessment had been carried out, it did not consider the residents' use of emollient cream.

In January 2022, the owners of the Care Home were found guilty of breaching the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. They were given a fine of £937,500 and ordered to pay London Fire Brigade's costs amounting to £104,425.

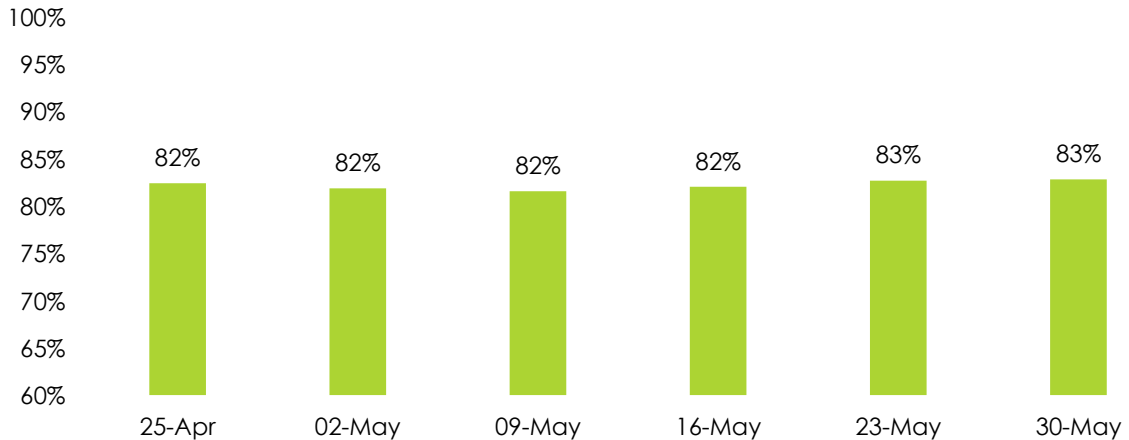

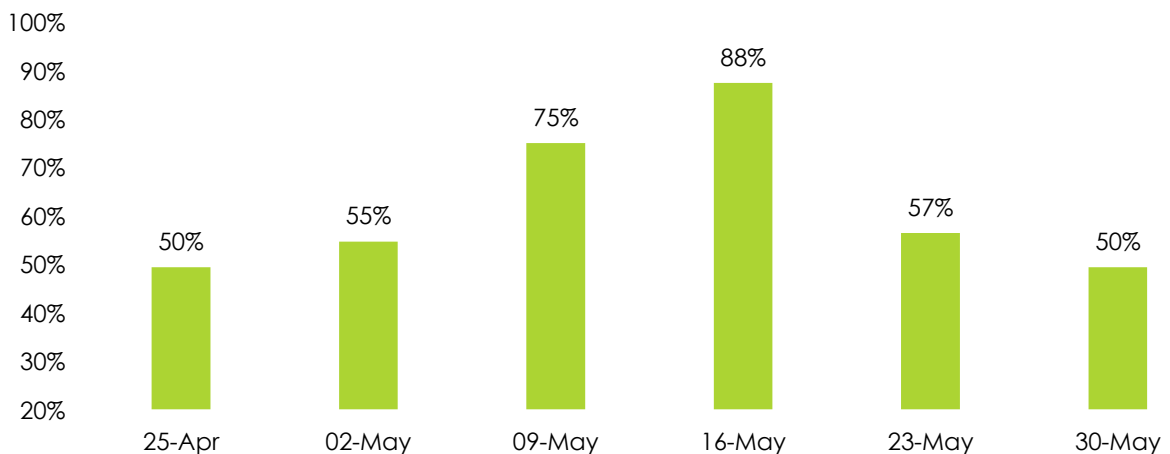
