

These learners will have had experience of a workplace and have an idea of what they want to do as a vocation. We will still explore this to ensure they are heading in the right direction for them.

It will involve creating a more complex CV, learning the process of looking for a suitable role, then gaining and sustaining that employment.

English, Maths & life skills are embedded in all sessions. We encourage learners to upskill their English & Maths and offer FS qualifications from EL1 to L2.

This will initially be 3 sessions a week from 10am – 4pm, dropping down to 2 sessions per week as work experience increases.

Work placements will be started in October with the aim that all learners are in placement by the end of October.

Work placement can be a period of weeks or months. If learners are not gaining value from a placement, we will work with them to gain further placements.

A learner can try different placements. It is never a one size fits all approach.

Learners are expected to undertake 2 – 3 days work placement a week. More than 16 hours a week. Each learner will need to achieve 460 works experience hours and 180 off the job hours during this year.

Learners will attend a 1:1 session at a specified time. This will last approximately an hour and is to check on learner welfare, discuss their progress that week and work on anything they need support with.

Learners are supported by a welfare officer, an LSA and a tutor. Groups are no more than 14 learners all with different abilities but with the same end goal.

Whilst we teach autonomy and encourage learners to take charge of their own journey, we are working hard behind the scenes with employer engagement to assist gaining placements. Learners are supported in placement by a job coach until the learner, the employer and us feel they are able to be independent.

We hope this overview of the programmes helps to give an idea of what we offer.
