Our Offer:

The Bradford Care Association (BCA) recognises the importance of Registered Managers, Clinical Leads and Nominated Individuals, the Leaders who play a crucial role in driving and maintaining quality of care services.

BCA aims to support these Leaders through a BCA Leadership Support offer, that includes access to: funded development programmes, regular networks and quality workshops, mentors, and peer support.

BCA seeks to support you whether you are experienced leader, new to a leadership role or aspiring to progress into a more senior role in a social care organisation.

BCA has been working to provide funding to offset the costs, or make them fully funded, for leadership development programmes. BCA has recently become a Skills for Care Workforce Development Fund (WDF) Partnership. BCA are also providing funds to support some of the costs of programmes and have gained access to West Yorkshire Skills Connect funding via Calderdale College.

Fully Funded Programmes:

Where programmes are funded by Skills for Care Workforce Development Fund (WDF), care providers are **required to pay for the cost of the programme to the Learning Provider prior to the programme start date** (e.g. a charge of £600 per person for Well-Led, Lead to Succeed and Leading Change Improving Care programmes).

However, on **successful completion of these programmes,** care providers can then claim £500 WDF monies per person* towards that cost via the BCA WDF Partnership (or other employer-led or national WDF Partnership)

BCA will also contribute £100 per person towards the cost, on completion of the above 3 programmes, to make them FULLY FUNDED for BCA members.

*in order to access WDF funding Care Providers need to:

- Already be a member of an employer-led or national WDF Partnership, or join the BCA WDF Partnership <u>(by completing the WDF Partnership Membership Form</u> and returning it to admin@bradfordcareassociation.org
- Complete the <u>Workforce Plan document</u> and return it to admin@bradfordcareassociation.org
- Register for the Skills for Care ADS-WDS for your Workplace before February 28th 2024 at <u>Skills for Care Registration Create Account</u>
- Complete the ASC-WDS before Feb 28th 2024, for your Workplace record and 90% of your staff records, as set out in the <u>Guidance</u>

Places for the above programmes should be booked at your earliest convenience, as will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. Please note that the Learning Provider reserves the right to charge you in full for non-attendance, if you or your Manager do not cancel the booked place prior to the programme commencing.
