

Leadership Development Programme

Following the huge success of the Leadership Development Programmes last year, Bradford Care Association (BCA) is planning to support new Registered Managers, Aspiring Managers and Deputies during 2026.

Once again, we have arranged access to the Skills for Care Lead to Succeed Programme which will be delivered by Leeds Leadership Academy.

The Leeds Leadership Academy is a Skills for Care quality assured care learning service and has demonstrated that it provides high-quality training that meets the needs of the workforce and those who rely on care and support.

The programme is fully funded and all details are outlined below.

This learning programme will be delivered by Leeds Leadership Academy, in January 2026 - March 2026 and further details are shown below. Care providers are required to pay £600 per person to attend the programme.

Leeds Leadership Academy has the right to charge in full for non-attendance, if a booked place is not cancelled prior to a programme commencing.

Eligible adult social care employers who successfully complete a training course can claim £525 towards costs from the Learning Development Support Scheme (LDSS) and an additional £75 from Bradford Care Association, making the course fully funded.

Funding is available for members of the adult social care workforce in England, and in order to qualify, their employer must meet all of the following criteria:

- Provide an adult social care service.
- Directly employ care staff in England.
- Have completed the <u>Adult Social Care Workforce Data Set (ASC-WDS)</u> and have an up to date account.
